Did you know that Creswell Crags is also protected as a Site of Special Scientific Interest (SSSi)? The magnesium limestone gorge is an important geological feature which attracts a variety of rare plants and species.

In addition to our unique environment we are surrounded by other special sites with the Peak District and Sherwood Forest within easy reach by car. A number of local attractions promote opportunities to see rare breeds or fauna including the glorious display of bluebells each year at Hodsock Priory and the variety of species at the Tropical Butterfly House, Wildlife & Falconry Centre.
