Holbeck Walk

Turn right out of the main visitor centre and walk towards the car park.

At the end of the car park on the left, is the war memorial. Go through the gate and continue along the Art Trail towards the A60.

At the main road, turn right and follow the tarmac footpath.


You will pass the entrance to The Courtyard, Welbeck on the opposite side of the road.

Contibue alongside the A60 until you reach a right-hand junction, signposted Holbeck Lane.

Turn right and follow Holbeck Lane. Please note, there is no footpath alongside this road, so proceed with caution.

Continue along Holbeck Lane to the village. If you wish to visit the church turn left, alternatively, take the footpath on the right, located 40m further on.

This footpath will bring you out onto open fields, which is part of the longer Robin Hood Way.





Follow the footpath over four styles/gates and pass the solar farm.

Steadily climb to the last style where you will come out on the top of a hill, known locally as Crags Hill, with open views of the village of Creswell.

Head down the hill and over a stone style into Creswell Crags.

Continue on this path and you will enter the limetone Gorge, with the lake ahead of you.

Follow the path to the left of the gorge, alongside Pin Hole Cave, Robin Hood Cave and Mother Grundy's Parlour.

At the end of the lake, take the middle path alongside Millwood Brook, through the Woodland Pass.

By the wooden sculpture, walk towards the left.

You will emerge by the Museum building. Turn right at the museum building to get to the cafe terrace.

Head through the cafe or walk along the building to return to the museum main entrance.
