



CAVES & CAVERNS ITINERARY



Nottinghamshire and Derbyshire are renowned for their caves and caverns. Nottingham is a city built upon a labyrinth of man made caves carved into the sandstone below and used for centuries as homes, storage, traders and finally air raid shelters. Derbyshire is known for its mines and caverns. Blue John is a rare precious stone which is only found in Castleton, Derbyshire. This village is rich in its variety of caverns including the Speedwell whose chambers are explored by boat.

Only Creswell offers a pre-historical experience with the only Ice Age Cave Art in the UK and evidence of occupation over 50,000 years.
